To ensure the highest possible standards of care and safety for our donors and recipients, it is essential that we are able to correctly identify each and every blood donor.

Regardless of if you have made one donation or a hundred, we will ask you for acceptable identification each time you donate.

We appreciate your time is precious and to ensure that you are properly prepared please ensure you have acceptable ID with you at your next donation.

Examples of ID that may be suitable include:

- NZBS Blood Donor Card
 - In addition you will also be asked to verbally verify your full name, date of birth and address
- Birth Certificate (in English)
- Driver's Licence (in English)
- Passport (name and date of birth must be easily identified)
- School ID Card (must include full legal name, photo and date of birth)
- University ID Card
- Polytechnic Student ID Card
- Employee ID Card
- The HANZ 18+ Card
- NZ Firearms Licence

Changes to Donor Names

For existing donors, where there is a change in name due to marriage or by deed poll, donors must provide evidence confirming their existing record and must also provide evidence confirming their name change. Acceptable forms of documentation are:

- Marriage certificate
- Divorce decree
- Statutory name change document
- Passport
- Driver's Licence

Providing this documentation will enable us to update our records.

Please note scanned or photocopied documents cannot be accepted.
