To ensure the highest possible standards of care and safety for our donors and recipients, it is essential that we are able to correctly identify each and every blood donor.

If you have made one donation or a hundred, we will now ask you for acceptable identification each time you donate.

We appreciate your time is precious and to ensure that you are properly prepared for your next donation, we are providing this information about what information you will need to bring with you at your next donation.

What is Acceptable ID?

Acceptable ID is a document or combination of documents, which contains three (3) unique points of personal information. These can be:

- NZBS Donor ID Number
- Full name
- Photograph
- Date of birth
- Home address
- Workplace (for employee work ID cards only)
- School (for School ID cards only)

Examples of ID that may be suitable include:

- Driver's Licence
- Passport (in English)
- School ID Card (must feature 3 of the items listed above) – one of which must be a photo
- Employee ID Card (must feature 3 of the items listed above) – one of which must be a photo
- The HANZ 18+ Card

- The current NZBS Donor Card will be sufficient identification provided you are able to verbally verify some additional details from your computer record. (This may include questions about your date of birth, home address and phone number.)

Changes to Donor Names

For existing donors, where there is a change in name due to marriage or by deed poll, donors must provide evidence confirming existing record and must also provide evidence confirming name change before changes can be made in the NZ Blood Donor Database. Acceptable forms of documentation are:

- Marriage certificate
- Divorce decree
- Statutory name change document
- Passport
- Driver's licence

Please be assured that your donation is very valuable to us and to members of your community. So please remember to bring suitable identification with you for your next donation as we will be unable to accept your donation without it.
